Code of Conduct

Some of the key aspects include the following:

Respect and Fair Play

Safety and Welfare

Behaviour Expectations

- Swearing, inappropriate language, and aggressive behaviour are prohibited.

Training and Games

- Players should arrive on time for training sessions and games, with the necessary equipment.

- Parents and spectators should encourage and support all players, avoiding negative comments or criticism.

Equal Opportunity

- All players should be given equal opportunities to participate and develop within training sessions and games.
- Coaches should strive to provide balanced playing time for all team members during games.

Health and Well-being

- Any injuries or illnesses should be reported to the coach immediately, and appropriate medical advice should be sought.

Communication

- Open and respectful communication between players, coaches, parents, and club officials is encouraged.
- Concerns or complaints should be addressed promptly and fairly through the appropriate channels.

Commitment

- Coaches should be committed to continuous improvement, ensuring that all coaches will change “with the times” seeking opportunities for professional development.
